CALL FOR PAPERS

SCRIPTed – A Journal of Law, Technology and Society, invites submissions for the forthcoming August issue and future issues of the journal.

SCRIPTed is a high-quality, online, international, interdisciplinary journal of peer-reviewed articles, analysis pieces, case and legislation critiques relating to law, society and technologies in the broadest sense. We also publish reports, and book reviews pertaining to these issues. Subject matter can be international or domestically oriented, and comparative approaches are welcomed. Specific areas of interest may include, but are by no means restricted to:

The interaction of law and regulation with:

- (1) **Digital Technology and Software** (artificial intelligence, telecommunications, cyberspace, networked environments, digital Copyright, proprietary Software, free software, copyleft, open source and other licensing schemes, etc.);
- (2) **Medical Technologies** (reproductive technologies, health related biotechnologies and public health, access to medicines, bioethics, etc.); and
- (3) **Genomics** (traditional knowledge, genetic resources and diversity, etc.); and

The interaction of technologies with, and their impact on:

- (4) **Intellectual Property** (copyright, patents, registered and unregistered marks and designs, brands, personality, licensing, etc.);
- (5) **Commercialisation** (economics, competition, e-commerce, m-commerce, internet finance, online dispute resolution, etc.);
- (6) **Human Rights** (freedom of expression, privacy, data protection, computer misuse, etc.);

Articles should not normally exceed 10,000 words (including footnotes). Analysis Pieces should normally not exceed 4,000 words. Case/Legislation Comments and Commentaries should not normally exceed 3,000 words. Book Reviews should not normally exceed 2,000 words. Any submission which exceeds the identified word counts may be accepted in exceptional circumstances upon special consideration of the Editorial Board.
